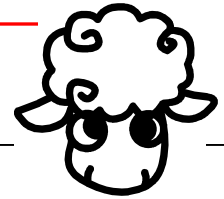

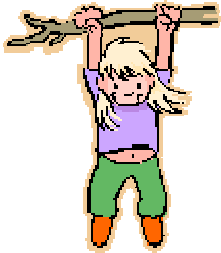

What would you say is the most important area of development in your child? Intellectual, physical, character, emotional, or spiritual?
