Our Mission and Vision

Children today are exposed to many ideas and values that promise fulfillment. However, many of these ideas and values neglect a child's greatest need, a personal relationship with Christ.

As a result of a lack of spiritual development in childhood, many children turn to drugs, violence, and immoral relationships during times of community or personal crisis.

Our heart is that every child and family would know the great love of Jesus Christ and enjoy the blessings of a personal relationship with God.

- Dynamic day care outreach programs in churches and privately owned day cares.
- Outstanding teacher training seminars and workshops to prepare teachers to lead effective biblically-based outreach in their church and community
- Parent enrichment classes to provide helpful tools and guidance for the spiritual development of their children

Our Concept

We train adults to take the church to the children in their neighborhoods, public schools, and day cares. Adults can conduct weekly neighborhood Bible clubs where children naturally live and play.

Our day care programs meet for 30 minutes, once a week. Our Bible club programs are in partnership with Child Evangelism Fellowship and meet for one hour once a week in a home, recreation facility, or public school.

We also coordinate special evangelism events; i.e., Mardi Gras Outreach, Jesus Film Fest, and block parties.

Children outreach helps by:

- Transforming the child and the environment he lives and plays in
- Providing positive Christian role models
- Teaching children how to turn to Christ and the Bible for real answers
- Addressing issues children face with Biblical truth
- Building a relationship between the child and the parent to provide spiritual guidance and instruction for the challenges they face



Our Program

Throughout the year we offer workshops and seminars to equip teachers and parents for children outreach and spiritual development

Day Care Outreach: Adults participate in a six hour seminar and assist a trained adult in a weekly day care bible class. Once the adult feels prepared they can begin their own day care outreach program with a team of trained helpers.

After School Bible Clubs: Adults participate in a six hour Saturday seminar and volunteer with a team of teachers serving in a local public school or community center.

Parent Enrichment: Parents attend a six hour Saturday seminar and receive instruction and tools to equip them as spiritual leaders in their home.

Teacher Training: We provide workshops and seminars to train adults in effective children's ministry and outreach.
