## Matthew 27:25-26

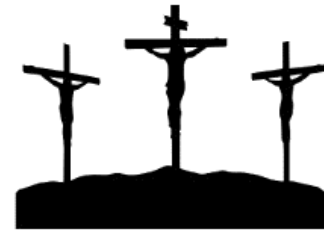


# WHIP

## Matthew 27:29

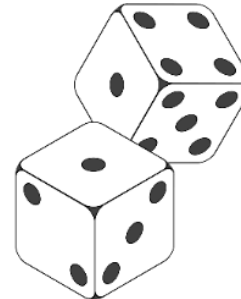


# CROWN

# DICE

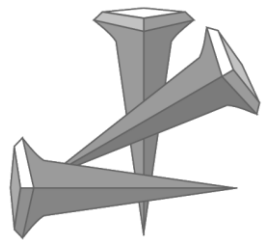
## Matthew 27:35

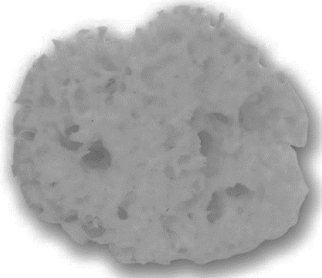
# DARKNESS

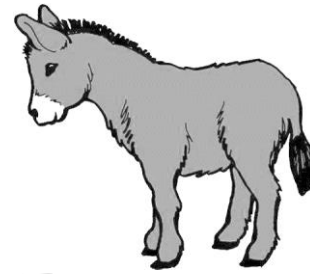
**SPONGE**
