Faithfulness

As God always fulfills His promises, so must we toward others and Him.

Peace

A calmness that comes from knowing that God is in control.

Fruit of the Spirit

...is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. (*Growth* of God's love in your heart and actions) *Galatians 5:22-23*

Goodness

Putting God's righteousness into action.

Gentleness

Showing our strength is controlled by His love and goodness.

Knowing God only allows problems that we can handle with His help.

Love

Joy

Rejoice in the Lord always,

Philippians 4:4 But let the righteous be glad and celebrate before God. Let them **rejoice** with gladness! Psalm 68:3

Love

Jesus answered him, "If anyone **loves** me, he will keep my word, and my Father will **love** him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. John 14:23

Goodness

Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, **gentle**, showing all humility to all men.

For we are His creation, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God <u>prepared ahead of time</u> so that we should walk in them.
